1.7	CCTV was mentioned - Gareth stated that Darwen have been trying to get one in a "Hot Spot" area but it is proving to be very difficult. Hyndburn Council are still trying to sort one out for Belthorn.	
1.8	Yvonne Brown (villager) said that she received an anonymous letter 2/3 weeks ago regarding cruelty to her pony. Yvonne made it very clear that this was nonsense - her pony has to have restricted grazing due to Laminitis or would have to be put down. Yvonne has had a visit from the Horse and Pony Protection Association who confirmed that she is not doing anything wrong at all - everything was ok. Gareth recommended that she kept the letter in case it leads to harassment.
